Fisheries sector is a significant source of food, nutrition, employment, income and livelihood opportunities. This sector provides livelihood to over 25 million fishers and fish farmers at the primary level and double the number along the value chain. Globally, human society faces the challenge to provide food security and livelihood for a population well in excess of 9 billion people by the middle of the 21st century. Contribution of fisheries and aquaculture to the food, nutrition and employment for the expanding populations around the world is gaining importance. India is the second largest fish producing country in the world which accounts for 6.56% of the global production. Fisheries and aquaculture sectors contributed around 1.24% to India's Gross Value Added (GVA), and over 7.28% to the Agricultural GVA during 2018-19 (DoF, MoF&AH, 2020).

Realising the necessity to support a surge in both domestic consumption and exports, the fisheries sector requires concentrated direction and strategic reforms. In this regard, the Government of India has announced a new flagship scheme, Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), with a significant investment of Rs. 20,050 crores, for the holistic development of the country's fisheries sector.

AFSIB Awards

Young Scientist Award

Eligibility: Scientists and Research Scholars below the age of 35 years (as on 31st March 2022) working in the field of fisheries related disciplines. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 3000 and a citation (up to 10 awards).

Prof. H.P.C Shetty Award

Eligibility: Persons involved in Fisheries research and development, below 50 years as on 31st March 2022. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 25,000 a medallion and an invitation to deliver keynote address at the forum.

Professors T.J. Pandian and A.J. Matty Award

Eligibility: Applicant should be below 35 years (40 years in the case of women) as on 31st March 2022, preferably carried out his/her work in India and has worked towards aquaculture development through research. Award carries a cash prize of Rs. 15,000, a medallion and an invitation to deliver keynote address at the forum.

Dr. Pillay Aquaculture Award

Eligibility: Outstanding work on any aspect of aquaculture (research/ extension/ development) carried out in India by an individual, group or organization (government or private). The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 25,000 and a citation and invitation to deliver keynote address during the forum.

Dr M.C. Nandeesh Awar

This award is for best innovation by a fish farmer which has helped to improve the productivity of the culture systems The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 25,000 and a citation.
