The establishment of Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University was the culmination of efforts during the period, 1955 to 2005 to strengthen education and services in the fields of Veterinary Science, Dairy Technology and Fishery Science in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The establishment of three Veterinary Colleges, the first at Bapatla during 1955, the second at Gannavaram during 1998 and the third at Proddatur during 2008, paved the way for strengthening Veterinary education in the state. The Veterinary College at Bapatla was shifted to Tirupati during December, 1957. The College of Fishery Science was started at Muthukur, Nellore Dt. during 1991. The Dairy Technology Programme was started in 1983 at the College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati and was elevated to college status during June, 2009. The University was created during the year 2005 by bifurcating the faculty of Veterinary Science comprising of Veterinary Science, Fishery Science and Dairy Science from Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhara Reddy inaugurated Sri Venkateswara Veterinary University in the premises of College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati on 15 July 2005 coinciding with the valedictory function of Golden Jubilee celebrations of College of Veterinary Science, Tirupati.

NTR College of Veterinary Science, Gannavaram is located opposite to Vijayawada Airport on the Chennai-Kolkata Highway (NH-5) and is 18 Km from Vijayawada Railway Station. Abstract of paper should be based on the original work/concept of the author(s) and must not have published anywhere. Name of the presenting author should be underlined. Only quality papers will be selected for presentations in the relevant technical sessions.

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by a scientific committee and decision regarding acceptance/rejection will be communicated to the corresponding authors.

Presentations:

Oral: Only by power point, not exceeding 20 min for lead papers and 5 min for other papers followed by 2 min of discussion for each.

Poster: Poster size should be 150 cm width and 90 cm height and the presenters should bring their own pins for display of the poster on the board. The poster should be informative, self explanatory and attractive in look.
